LOCATION AND TRAVEL INFORMATION

In preparation for the August Colloquium, we have compiled some information which we hope will be useful regarding Kerala, the location of the event and main contact details.

The Colloquium is being held at the high school campus of Sri Adwayananda Public School in the village of Malakkara, located midway between two international airports, Kochi (COK) and Trivandrum (TRV).

For your convenience we have added a Kerala map where you can see the location of the school in relation to the international airports as well as a more local map reflecting the location of the Lower Primary and High School campuses.

Many of the guests attending this event will be accommodated at a lovely home stay called the *Malakkarethu House* which has been exclusively booked for International Colloquium. 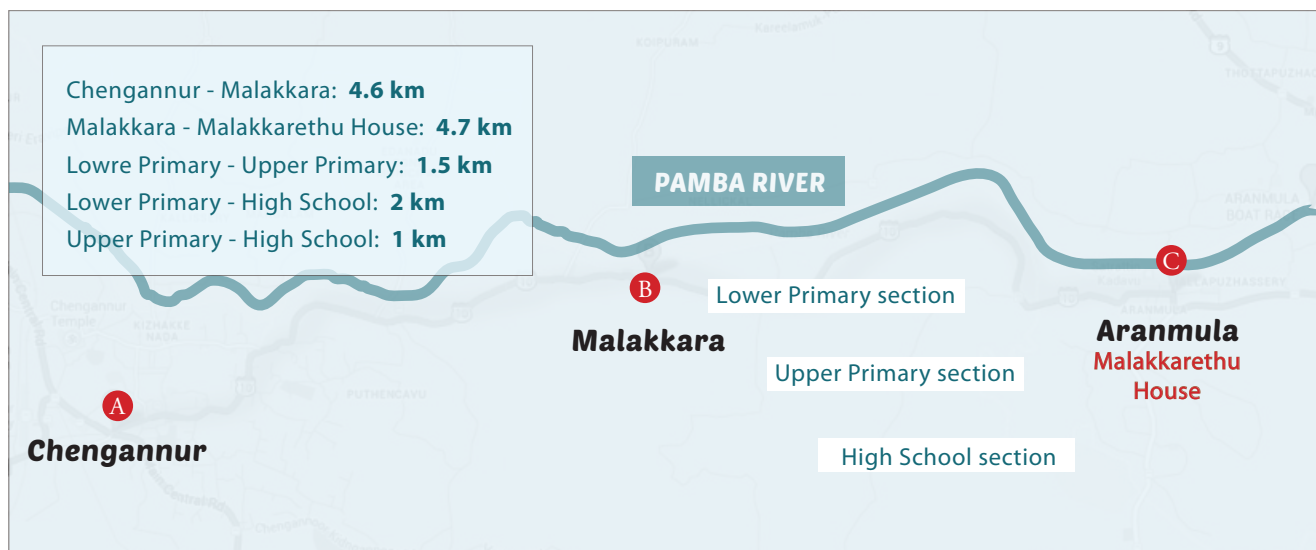
Distance from International Airports to Malakkara

KERALA INFORMATION

Nominated in National Geographic's Traveler magazine in 2009 as one of "50 Places of a Lifetime", Kerala is considered one of the most beautiful states in India. With the Western Ghats to the east and Arabian Sea to the west, Kerala is located in South India, well known for its tranquil backwaters, brilliant green rice paddies and exotic spice plantations. With a nearly 100% literacy rate and India's lowest infant mortality rate, it has one of the highest standards of living in the country.

Kerala is host to 3 international airports, Thiruvananthapuram (Trivandrum), Kozhikode (Calicut), and Kochi (Cochin) and is well connected with train and bus transport throughout the state. The spoken language is Malayalam, and the religious composition of the state is Hindu, Muslim, Christian and Jewish, having one of the oldest Jewish settlements in India, settled in 1524 by the ruler of Kochi (Cochin).
